about an account but you are not been authorised by the account access account information: holder to access the account, the Authority cannot give you that information.


If you are not the account holder or registered on the account as a tenant, you must have either: a) a copy of the bill you are seeking to pay; or, b) know beforehand the account number and the amount due to be paid.

Cashiers cannot accept payments from persons who are not the account holder unless they are presented with either a copy of the bill, or with the account number and amount to be paid.
