1. It's economical.

By switching to piped water, **you save Cl\$1.50 per cubic metre** (m³). Piped water costs just Cl\$22.60 per 1000 US gallons versus Cl\$28.27 per 1000 US gallons of trucked water.

And, if you apply for piped water before 31 December, 2015, the Authority will waive the CI\$80.00 connection fee!

2. It's reliable.

All trucked water deliveries are made on a "first come, first served" basis as per the Trucked Water Delivery Policy. Depending on the number of orders for trucked water, you may experience delivery delays that cause you to go without water.

Piped water, on the other hand, is consistently available, even during electrical power outages when cistern and well pumps will not work.

3. It's safe.

The Authority consistently monitors the safety and quality of the water produced in its Reverse Osmosis (RO) plants. Water quality is tested during and after the treatment process at different stages, including at regular intervals throughout the piped distribution network.

The Authority cannot, however, guarantee the safety or quality of its water once it enters a private cistern/holding container. If not properly maintained, these cistern/personal holding containers could cause the water to become contaminated and unfit for human use or consumption.

3. It's environmentally friendly.

Using water produced by the Authority's RO plants reduces the strain on groundwater wells, helping to protect the Cayman Islands groundwater resources from the threats of contamination and over-use.



As of October 2015, the Water Authority's piped water distribution network extends from Brac Reef Beach Resort on Channel Road, along the south coast to Gerard Smith Avenue, Cross Road and along West End East Road (please see the map above, installed pipelines are marked in red).

In 2015, the Authority expanded the pipeline along West End East Road and a number of side roads between Tibbetts Square and the West End Primary School. Roads with access to piped water now include: Amberville Lane, Barney's Road, an unnamed road off West End East Road, White Bay Road, Moon Lane, Lily's Lane, Venus Close, Pioneer Lane, Ethel Rose Road, Dream Lane, Savory Close, and Cemetery Road.

The pipeline is expected to reach Faith Hospital by mid-2016.
