Every year the Authority offers a scholarship of up to CI\$30,000 to a suitably qualified Caymanian to obtain an undergraduate academic or technical/vocational degree or diploma in a field of study relevant to our work.

To be eligible to apply for the Authority's Annual \$30,000 Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be Caymanian
- Be 18 years or older
- Be in good health
- Be of good character
- Demonstrate financial need

 May already be enrolled at an institution and be in good academic standing

The Authority encourages students and recent graduates to apply for a summer internship to experience first-hand the variety of careers available in the water and wastewater utilities industry.
